

***Curriculum vitae* of GIUSEPPE DE ROSA**

Giuseppe De Rosa is a full professor in Animal production at Department of Agriculture (*Dipartimento di Agraria*) of University of Naples Federico II. He has more than 30 years experience in animal welfare research. He has published extensively in scientific journals. An extensive part of his work was related to behaviour, housing and welfare. He has gained experience on the utilisation and analysis of physiological, immune, behavioural, health and productive indicators of animal welfare. At European level he was involved, as national expert, in the Working Group of COST (European Co-operation in the Field of Scientific and Technical Research) ACTION 846 "Measuring and Monitoring Farm Animal Welfare". He was involved in the European project Welfare Quality® (www.welfarequality.net) aimed to develop European standards for on-farm welfare assessment. He headed a Research Unit participating at a project on organic farming financed by Regione Marche. He is a member of the Editorial board of the journals "Journal of Buffalo Science" (Lifescience Global, Mississauga, Canada) and "Dairy" (MDPI, Basel, Switzerland). Since 1990 he has joined the International Society for Applied Ethology (ISAE). His research activity is documented by more than 100 papers published mostly on international journals. His research work is integrated with intense academic activities.
