Curriculum Vitae Prof. Leonardo Nanni Costa

Leonardo NANNI COSTA is a full professor of Animal Husbandry at the Department of Agricultural and Food Sciences (DISTAL) at the University of Bologna, Italy. He received his PhD in Animal Science at the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine in Milan. Prof. Nanni Costa held the position of associated professor to the chair of Animal Husbandry at the Faculty of Agriculture of Bologna University from 1992 to 2007. He was scientific responsible for several research projects supported by the EU and Italian Ministries of Health and Research. His research has focused mainly on pork production and animal welfare during transport. In 2010 and 2020 he joined EFSA (Food Safety Authority – Animal Health Animal Welfare Panel) producing a scientific report on animal transport requested by the European Commission. From 2006 he collaborates with the Ministry of Health producing a part of the national report requested by Regulation CE No. 1/2005. Prof. Nanni Costa was a member of the Ethics Committee for the protection of animals used for experimental purposes at the University of Bologna, past director of the Dept. of Agricultural and Food Sciences and member of the commission for National Scientific Qualification (ASN). He is Director of the degree course "Animal production". He published more than 200 papers in national and international scientific journals.
