Graduated in **Economics** in 1987 with a thesis on “The theories of Diffusion on Innovations and the Technology Transfer”(Supervisor Prof. A. Del Monte), Maria Patrizia Vittoria obtained a Degree Award from the *Fondazione ASSI, Fondazione Adriano Olivetti, and ISUC-Ex-Officine Bosco in Terni*.

Her first research assignment was from the Progetto Finalizzato CNR “Analisi e Struttura dell’Economia Italiana” (Prof. G. Vaciago). In this context, she contributed with a research about the process of industrialization in Southern Italy and the role of public policies. The research contribution was co-authored with A. Del Monte and published in a book edited by F. Padoa Schioppa Kostoris, entitled *Squilibri e rigidità nel Mercato del Lavoro Italiano: Rilevanza Quantitativa e Proposte Correttive*, F. Angeli, Milano, 1993.

Maria Patrizia Vittoria obtained her PhD in “Economics and Management of Public Firms” in 2011, from DISA-MIS, *Department of Business Sciences-Management and Innovation Systems (University of Salerno)*.

Since 2001, she is Senior Researcher at the National Research Council (CNR) of Italy, Institute for Research on Innovation and Services for Development (IRISS).

Her **areas of interest** include:

- A) Analysis of the processes of birth and formation of **New firms** as resulting from the emerging dynamics of industrial reorganization of the late 1980s, and subsequently of those that characterize the Innovative Firm, in particular, the examination of the innovation process, the nature and boundaries of firms, considering preeminently their persistent heterogeneity, as regards behavior, organization and performance.
- B) Analysis of **Knowledge Networks** as new economic institutions whose focus is to organize the processes of knowledge creation and dissemination. In this context, greater attention has been paid to the identification of their respective regional policy milieus.
- C) Study of **Informal Communities**, in particular of civic and participatory initiatives, not least those inspired by the Commons’ principles, and their potential for territorial development.
