Since November 2021 he has retired as Professor of Clinical Psychology in the Faculty of Medicine and Psychology of which he was Vice Dean (2011-2013) and Dean (2014-2016). Since 2017 he coordinates Sapienza's Unit for Internal Evaluation, that he has chaired also from 2005 to 2013. In 2007 he organized the second European Quality Assurance Forum in Rome

From 2012 he collaborated with ANVUR in the development of the evaluation accreditation system AVA; he is a system and disciplinary expert. He chaired or participated in the CEV for the accreditation of several Italian universities. He has collaborated in site visits of the Swiss OAQ and the Austrian Accreditation Council, as well as in the EU EQuAM projects and in the EU LLP International Medical Schools.

He is the author of publications in health psychology, psychometrics, clinical psychophysiology and on sleep disorders.

Born D. in Philosophy (Sapienza, 1974). Fulbright and M.A. in Behavior Analysis (W. Michigan University 1976). CNR Fellow (1976-1980). Visiting researcher at CAL Berkeley and Stanford University (1978). At Sapienza he has been a researcher in Psychology (1980-87); associate professor of Physiological Psychology (1988-94) and Methodology (1994-2000); then full professor of General Psychology (2001-2007) and of Clinical Psychology (since 2008). At Sapienza he has chaired the BA course in Social Service (2006-2008) and the Master course in Health Clinical and Community Psychology (2008-2011). Since 2011 he has been vice dean and then dean (2014-2016) of the Faculty of Medicine and Psychology and member of the SC of the Sant'Andrea Hospital. He was a member of the National Council for Universities (1997-2008) and involved since 2000 in the evaluation and quality assurance of universities at national and European level. He was a member and chair of the Committee for Psychotherapies of the Ministry for University and Research (2013-2019). From 2017 he chairs the Evaluation Unit of Sapienza, that he has previously chaired from 2005 to 2013. In 2007 he was the local organizer of the 2nd European Quality Assurance Forum in Rome.

In 2012-2013 he collaborated with the national agency ANVUR in the development of the evaluation accreditation system AVA, and he is a system and disciplinary expert. He chaired or participated in the expert committees (CEV) for the accreditation of several Italian universities (Aquila, Macerata, Turin, Federico II, Padua, HSR). He has collaborated in site visits of the Swiss OAQ and the Austrian Accreditation Council, as well as in the EU EQuAM projects coordinated by UB Obreal and in the EU LLP International Medical Schools.

He teaches health psychology and clinical psychology in the faculties of Medicine and Psychology and of Pharmacy and Medicine, and in the doctorate in Cognitive neurosciences. Engaged in research on sleep since 1978, since 2000 he is involved with psychology applied to health and clinical issues. His studies on sleep dealt with regulation and disturbances of sleep and vigilance cycle, while those in clinical and health psychology deal with quality of life, health behaviors, emotion regulation, adherence to care, work related stress. He coordinated the unit for sleep disorders (1996-2008) and the clinical group of the Department of Psychology (led a program for the prevention of burn out and work related stress at the San (2017-2019) and in 2020 the trainings for Sapienza's Covid-19 SC4C project. He has dozens of scientific publications and is a member of international and national s
