My main interest is textual criticism: since 2003 I work regularly for the “Bibliotheca scriptorum Graecorum et Romanorum Teubneriana” (now De Gruyter Verlag, Berlin-Boston). I work also as official reviser for the french series “Les belles lettres. Collection des universités de France” (currently as reviser of the edition of Choricus of Gaza) and I am been involved in the preparation of some Oxford editions (Bibliotheca classica Oxoniensis: Suetonius, Varro, Cato). The committee for the publication of the *Opera omnia* of Erasmus of Rotterdam (Desiderii Erasmi *Opera omnia*, Leiden, Brill) has entrusted me with the edition of six *opuscula* about the text of the *Novum Testamentum* (I have already delivered four *opuscula*).

I am a member of the *wissenschaftlicher Beirat* of *Hyperboreus. Studia classica* (Saint Petersburg – Munich, Beck Verlag).
